

Clean lines: rectangular basic shapes for hardware on front doors

The trend towards angular hardware on doors and windows continues unabated. Clean lines and edges are currently an extremely popular design element in hardware – including on front doors! This creates a modern minimalist look in line with the latest architectural trends. This popular design can be implemented on the outside of front doors, either with rectangular pull handles or with traditional security sets – on the inside of the front door, half sets from the Dallas, Detroit and Liverpool series continue the modern approach inside the home.

All in stainless steel: rectangular pull handles and security sets

The basic shape of the new stainless steel pull handles from HOPPE is rectangular or square now, too. Even the supports, which secure the pull handle to the front door, follow the new shape. The clean lines can be ideally complemented with rectangular escutcheons and security escutcheons – including tested burglary-resistant versions (ES 1 and SK 2). And anyone who would rather have a traditional security set installed on their front door instead of a pull handle can choose from rectangular security sets in the Detroit and Dallas series – now also in stainless steel. These are of course tested to EN 1906 (SK 2-4) and certified according to DIN 18257 (ES 1-3).

Also for the inside of front doors: clean lines – fast to install

If the angular design concept is to be implemented on the entire front door, the striking handle and escutcheon shapes in the Dallas, Detroit and Liverpool series complement the modern design on the inside of the front door – naturally also in stainless steel! The HOPPE mounting module for roses with Quick-Fit connection also ensures that the sets from the Dallas and Detroit series are particularly easy to be installed. This is because the new module combines several components in one compact unit, resulting in fewer parts and noticeably fewer installation steps. A spring cassette (suitable for right and left hand) is securely integrated into the module and, together with the steel supporting lugs, ensures that the perfect fit of the set on the door.
