

Strong protection for windows

During a forced entry attempt, some perpetrators don't even shy away from a locked window handle, but make every effort to overcome the lock with force. A window handle equipped with special reinforcements – or one with a locking mechanism that is very difficult to attack – can protect you against this.

During a forced entry attempt, burglars often try – with various methods and tools – to reach and move the window handle through the window glass. HOPPE window handles with Secu100® + Secustik® offer proven protection against such attacks from the outside: Secu100® ensures that the locked window handle cannot be forcibly turned or torn off – in accordance with current burglary resistance standards, it does so up to a force of 100 Newton metres. Secustik® also includes a patented blocking mechanism that prevents the hardware from being displaced from the outside.

SecuSelect® effectively protects windows

With SecuSelect®, HOPPE offers another effective security feature: the keyed cylinder is no longer located in the handle itself, but in the rosette body. The window remains securely closed even when an attempt is made to overcome the locking mechanism by forcibly turning the handle. The handle is broken off when the burglar applies a force higher than 100 Newton metres – for example by using a heavy tool or a very long lever, – while the rosette, which contains the locking mechanism, remains firmly attached to the window profile. Burglars therefore have no area to attack and are unable to overcome the lock. The break-in is foiled.

Easy to operate

SecuSelect® window handles are designed to be particularly user-friendly thanks to an oversize reversible key and a push cylinder: you lock them with a quick push on the keyed cylinder; a half-turn of the key is enough to unlock them again. Users can select the position of the keyed cylinder on the rosette – according to their preferences, it is on the top or bottom of the rosette. Furthermore, the distance between the handle and the window profile is increased, which makes operating the handle even easier.

SecuSelect® window handles also offer something special with their design: the rosette is designed in a way that it can be combined with many different handle models from HOPPE – even with those that are normally used only for interior doors. This allows you, for example, to use your favourite door handle on the window or to fit each window with individual handles – the design possibilities are virtually unlimited!
