Moreover, they are very compact, meaning that installation is trouble-free for the installer: no need for any milling – all that is required is to route a cable to the motor lock from the pull handle supports or the knob. The familiar HOPPE fixing system can also still be used.

Flat roses have been an especially popular expression of modernity for some time now. Now, the minimalist-style flat roses are available for windows too. The Austin series makes switching to the modern visual style particularly easy: certain versions are straightforward to retro-fit – including for the enduser – and thus have a unique advantage in the retro-fitting business. Thanks to four variants with and without Secustik® technology and/or as key lockable versions with Secu100®, the new series not only looks really good, it also includes tried-and-tested anti-break-in technology. The Secustik® models are also available with the adjustable square spindle developed by HOPPE.
